Turn the following sentences into negative and interrogative using present perfect simple:

1. The plumber has fixed / 's fixed (fix) the water tap.

**Negative:** The plumber hasn't fixed the water tap / the plumber has not fixed the water tap / The plumber has not fixed the water tap / the plumber has not fixed the water tap .

**Question:** Has the plumber fixed the water tap / has the plumber fixed the water tap ?

2. The carpenter has made / 's made (make) a nice table.

**Negative:** The carpenter hasn't made a nice table / the carpenter hasn't made a nice table / The carpenter has not made a nice table / the carpenter has not made a nice table .

**Question:** Has the carpenter made a nice table / has the carpenter made a nice table ?

3. She has already arrived / 's already arrived (already / arrive). ( )

**Negative:** She hasn't arrived yet / She has not arrived yet / She's not arrived yet . ( )

**Question:** Has she arrived yet / Has she arrived yet ? ( )
